Covid 19

After the recent announcement by the government regarding the lifting of Covid 19 restrictions we have decided that, in order to keep everyone as safe as possible, we will be continuing with our current routines. - Children who are unwell or have symptoms that could be Covid 19 should not attend nursery.

- Face masks should still be worn inside the building – please take one from the hall table if you have forgotten yours.

We appreciate your co-operation with this. It may be that other nurseries and schools locally will have different arrangements to ours; we are now required to look to our own Health and Safety policies and make arrangements that suit our nursery and its users and staff.
